

# Musical Explorers

What do you do when your child has outgrown baby music sessions, but isn't yet ready for formal music lessons?

**Musical Explorers** sessions are designed to bridge that gap, nurturing children's musical creativity, and supporting and empowering their musical journeys.

We introduce and explore the basic elements of music (pulse, pitch, rhythm, timbre, articulation) via multi-sensory activities.

Jointly delivered by [Rhythm Circle](#) and [B'Opera](#), our approach is grounded in good practice from Early Years education methods and exploratory play. All classes are delivered by highly-trained teachers with extensive musical training and experience.

# About our online sessions

- Small group / 10 children - to maximise individual attention.
- All sessions will be run and taught live online on Zoom by a DBS checked Rhythm Circle / B'Opera teaching staff.
- Our Zoom sessions are secure, private and password - protected. Weekly invitations will be sent out so that you can join the sessions. You will need to download the Zoom app (available on the App store or Google play). To get the best experience, we advise running the app on a tablet, laptop or desktop as a smartphone screen is too small to see details clearly.
- Upon joining the Zoom sessions, all participants will be put in a virtual 'waiting room' and let into the session at the start time.

## Materials

You will need **paper, pencils, marker pens / coloured pencils / crayons.**

**A weekly email with download links** will be sent for the following week.

Any specific materials needed will be either posted to you in advance or a list will be sent - don't worry, we won't be asking you for anything unusual like sandpaper or drumkits!



The materials we ask you to gather will be easily found in the home environment like sugar, lemons, pots and pans, torches.
